## TO RAISE SUPPORT FOR MERCY MEDICAL CENTER REDDING'S EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT EXPANSION & REMODEL

### Why

- Current facility designed for 44,000 annual patients (last expansion in 1996)
- Projections: 55,000 patients will come to ED in 2011; 57,000 in 2015
- Expanded ED will accommodate 66,000 patients a year and is projected to meet needs through 2025
- To enhance patient privacy and operations
- 50% of the hospital's inpatient admissions come through the ED
- Far Northern California's most advanced trauma center with 24-hour emergency care serving the counties of Shasta, Siskiyou, Tehama, and Trinity

### What

#### Increase Capacity & Enhance Privacy:

- 4,165 sq. ft. expansion and 11,853 remodel
- 30 patient bays (currently there are 22 patient bays)
  - 28 private patient bays
    - \*Two isolation rooms for infectious patients
    - \*Two treatment rooms for psychiatric patients
  - Two state-of-the-art trauma bays

#### Increase Efficiency:

- New ambulance and patient drop-off area
- Improved and expanded parking
- Additional staff support space, so the ED will have:  
3 nurses' stations, 2 medication rooms, & 2 physician charting rooms  
(Now there is 1 nurses' station, 1 medication area and 1 physician charting area)
- Remodel lab and radiology

#### Community Benefits:

- Shorten the average time a patient spends in the ED
- Enhance patient comfort levels while improving efficiency
- Integrates "green" design strategies
